As advised in Gas Watch 40, Sydney Gas has bought land in Broke adjacent to the residential area of the village.

It is the land where Sydney Gas drilled an exploration well in about 2004.

It is land under which there are aquifers and water tables, which support our bores.

It is land where drilling infrastructure, where gas extraction, methane seepage, and possible flaring, can affect the lives of everyone living in the Broke Village.

It is land where the drilling of exploration wells can ruin our bore water.

It is land where our bore water could be contaminated, similar to which occurred north of Newcastle - *"In September 2004, within a fortnight of the beginning of gas testing, a coal bed methane well north of Newcastle, NSW, was shut down as several boreholes up to 300m away began to blow off methane gas. This was the first reported case of a serious migration of methane gas from coal bed methane operations in New South Wales."*

Has there ever been a greater risk to the village of Broke?
